Note: Here is new frequency listing following updating to place on your radio. We have taken Horton FS Repeater and Ketchum out of scan to lessen the scan frequencies.

At night or at any other time you only want disturbed for a call from either Custer Dispatch (Channel 5) or our own Dispatch (Channel 1), turn to Channel 16. When on 16, both our (1) and Clinic (3) will tone us out. If you choose to leave the volume completely down, you will not hear any voice but will hear the tone out. When hearing tone out, turn up volume to see who is paging, Custer or us. It will be usual and customary, after being paged out by Custer, that other members of our team will be trained to again page us out via our own Repeater. In the future, we expect to have in place the ability for Blaine County to also dispatch us when they get a fire 911 call. This will save significant time as now they have to translate the incoming call to Custer who pages us out. As you may know, down valley 911 calls go to Custer and in our District they go to Blaine.
